# 2018 NOMINATIONS

The credit union's Nominating Committee, being Edward Gale Smith, Sr. (Chairperson), James "Tex" Whitfield and Donna Blevins, has nominated the following members to fill three positions on the Board of Directors.

## NOMINATED FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

**Brenda Jones**, a credit union member since 1990, worked at the paper mill in the Human Resources Department for nine years. Brenda served on the credit union Board of Directors for five years from 1993 through 1997. During that time, she held the offices of Membership Officer and later Secretary. Upon her re-employment with the Tembec paper mill, Brenda was elected to serve on the Board of Directors in April of 2003, and has served as the Secretary since 2004. Brenda is currently employed with the State of LA and is seeking re-election to the Board of Directors for a three year term.

**Jerri Ralph**, a credit union member since 1994, she was selected to serve on the Supervisory Committee (6/2011) and has served on the Board of Directors since 2012. Jerri has been employed by Turner Industries Group, L.L.C. since 1999. Her current position is Office Manager at their onsite office at ExxonMobil BRPO. Jerri Ralph is seeking to be re-elected to the Board of Directors for a three year term.

**Wilbert Scott**, a credit union member since 1981, has served on the Board of Directors since 1989. He has served as Vice President for one year and as President for four years. He has also served on the Supervisory Committee and currently serves as Treasurer/ Financial Officer. Wilbert was employed with Tembec paper mill for more than 24 years. He is now self-employed and is the owner of Arrow Fence Company, L.L.C. Wilbert Scott is seeking re-election to the Board of Directors for a three year term.

**Ann Menser**, joined the credit union in 1967 then re-joined in 1983 and has remained a member since that time. Ann was employed with Crown Zellerbach 12 years first as a Receptionist then in Accounts Payable, Billing, Shipping and Payroll Departments. When her husband was transferred to another area, she moved to Ciba Geigy where she worked another 6 years in Accounts Payable. When her husband was again transferred, she went to work for the Dept. of Corrections at the LA State Penitentiary in the Classification, Business Office and Offender Records departments. In 2016, she transferred to Dixon Correctional with a promotion to Supervisor of the Offender Records Dept. of which she has been employed for 30 years and plans to retire on November 1, 2017. Ann Menser was married to the Late Willie Menser for 45 years, she has two sons and two grandchildren. Mrs. Menser is seeking election to the Board of Directors for the unexpired two year term of Director Troy Jackson who resigned in 2017.

## REQUIREMENTS FOR NOMINATION BY PETITION

Any member who is interested in running for the Board of Directors in the 2018 election can have his/her name placed on the ballot by being nominated by petition. The member must:

1. Have at least 27 separate Feliciano FCU members' signatures
2. Write a letter of acceptance agreeing to all requirements
3. Provide biographical information including year of membership, time served on other committees (if any), professional occupation, years of employment, and in what capacity you are presently employed.

**Nominations must be postmarked and received at the address shown below no later than November 30, 2017.** Petitions received after that date are not valid and will not be included on the ballot for election. Please submit the signed petition, an acceptance letter, and the biographical data to Brenda Jones, FFCU Secretary of the Board of Directors, P.O. Box 1130, Zachary, LA 70791. If necessary, voting will be conducted prior to the April 21, 2018 Annual Membership Meeting. The specifics will be advertised in the newsletter, in the lobby of all credit union branches and on the credit unions web page. Ms. Jones has certified that nominations will not be accepted from the floor, as the Nominating Committee has slated one candidate for each vacancy. If there are no additional candidates, there will be no election by ballot.
